

SDHSAA Ticket Information – State Wrestling

SDHSAA Athletic Directors:

Please find attached information regarding SDHSAA State Wrestling Tickets as well as an order form for seating. Please note the following information regarding this year's combined tournament event:

- **ALL SPECTATORS MUST WEAR MASKS! Failure to abide by this policy will result in removal from the facility for the duration of the championships.**
- Tickets for the State Wrestling Tournament will be sold by the Civic Center in Rapid City. Member schools should only submit one order per school. This order must be received by the Civic Center no later than February 6. School orders received after February 6 will not be processed and must purchase tickets within the general public allotment.
- All adult tickets are sold as "Reserved Seats." **Due to Covid-19, anyone with a reserved seat ticket must sit in their assigned seat. Failure to abide by this policy will result in removal from the facility for the duration of the championships.**
- Student "general admission" tickets are also available for sale and will allow students to sit in the designated student sections. If a student wishes to sit in any other section, they must purchase a full-priced, reserved-seat ticket.
- All rounds of wrestling for Class "A" will occur in the Ice Arena. All rounds of wrestling for Class "B" will occur in the Barnett Arena (main arena at the Civic Center). **Tickets are specific to class – a separate ticket will need to be purchased for a spectator wishing to view both events.**
- Ticket orders for the Tournament should be sent directly to the Civic Center as listed on the following form..
- Each order must be accompanied by a single, school check or money order for the exact amount of that order. Checks must be made payable to the RUSHMORE PLAZA CIVIC CENTER. **Should any check be returned for insufficient funds, the entirety of that school's order will be cancelled and not refunded.**
- **There will be NO REFUNDS on ticket orders for any reason.**
- **NOTE to School Admin/Personnel:** Only those coaches who are listed on the schools' roster and have completed educational requirements will be credentialed up to the allowed number. There are no additional administrator/school supervision passes for wrestling – any such individual wishing to attend must purchase a ticket or consider volunteering to work the event!

B. Passes and Complimentary Tickets at State Tournament

1. Each contestant will be furnished a pass. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket)
2. Each Varsity Cheerleader in attendance will be furnished a pass, but not granted floor access. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket)
3. Student manager passes will be provided. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket, per season roster, maximum of two per team)
4. Complimentary tickets will be issued to a school as follows: (Coaches/Admin need to use these to enter, SDHSAA Pass)

Number of Qualifiers(Pass)	Complimentary Tickets
1	3
2	4
3	5
4 or more	6

One pass for a bus driver will be available if requested.

The High School Press Pass Request form is located in the School Zone, Fine Arts, Journalism section.

**Passes will be issued to the coach at the time of check-in for distribution to his school members.

D. State Tournament Reserved Seat Ticket Information – Combined Tournament, Rapid City

1. Member School Pre-Sale Ticket Orders
 - a. Only all-tournament tickets will be sold in advance.
 - b. Tickets for the Combined Tournament will be sold only by the host venue. There is no limit on the number of adult or student all-tournament tickets a school can purchase.
 - c. Each school order must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Civic Center for the exact amount of the order.
 - d. The deadline for School Orders to be received will be established by the SDHSAA Any orders received after that point will be filled in the order they are received and potentially mixed in with general public sales.
 - e. There are NO REFUNDS on ticket orders
2. General Public Pre-Sale Orders
 - a. The general public is encouraged to make their orders through their local school district to ensure they receive priority seating for the Tournament.
 - b. Members of the general public not ordering tickets through their school may contact the host site directly or purchase tickets online following school orders being placed.
 - c. As with the school orders, there are NO REFUNDS on any tickets purchased.
3. Ticket Prices:

4. Ticket Specifications:
 - a. All adults will be required to purchase a reserved seat ticket good for seating as assigned to gain entry.
 - b. Students wishing to sit with their school/parent groups must purchase a reserved seat ticket.
 - c. Discounted student tickets will be for seating in specified sections separate from team personnel.
 - d. Student Tickets are good for those in Grades 1-12. Kindergarten or younger are admitted free, but not necessarily provided a seat in the reserved section without a ticket. College students are considered adults and must purchase an adult ticket to gain entry.
 - e. Tickets may be purchased on the day of the event. Doors will 60 minutes prior to each of the sessions.
